What to Bring

- Sleeping Bag or Bedding for twin bed
- Pillow
- Towels
- Toiletries (shampoo, conditioner, body soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, deodorant, razors)
- Ladies- feminine products
- Modest clothing for hot and cool days (see dress code in Staff Rules)
- Shoes (sandals, hiking boots, rain boots-to shower girls in)
- Ladies- one piece swimsuit
- iPod, phone (Chargers!) Don't forget your Headphones...
- Bible and journals
- Paper, envelopes, and stamps (for those who want to send letters)
- Sun screen
- Medicine (Must have a Named and dated valid prescription)
- Water bottle
- Money
- Your own snacks that you can't live without
- PASSPORTS AND IDENTIFICATION!!!!

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Drugs (of any kind -prescribed or not), alcohol, cigarettes
- Medication without a prescription
- Guns, bullets, fireworks
- Knives over 3" (pocket knives are okay, i.e. Leatherman under 3 inches)
- Movies or secular music
- Plastic bags of clothes for donations (those will be confiscated at the border)

**If you are staying longer than a week you could be required to get a tourist visa (it is usually less than \$30 but they don't always make accurate change so bring a \$10, 2- \$5's, and 10-\$1's)*
