## Mission Project Updates

### Safety Inspection Progress

We have finally passed all of our inspections and have received our certification from Mexico to operate as an orphanage legally! Which has been ongoing for the past four years.

### Chapel Building Project

The chapel building project is well on its way with the foundation laid and walls partially built up including the windows and doors all framed in. The main electrical cable has been laid and we are waiting for the electrician in Mexico to come and finish the rest of wiring.

### Dental Clinic

The dental clinic-building project has been completed. The only piece lacking is the furnishings for the inside, with the exception of a dental chair and equipment.

## Mission Project Updates


### New Stove

We were so amazed to be able to raise the funds for a much-needed brand-new stove/oven to replace the old one that had provided delicious food for years. It was installed and is now running perfectly. The staff were very blessed by this as the old stove had a few problems that weren't able to be fixed. Many were involved in donating the funds needed to provide this essential appliance.



### New Roofs

A few of our roofs were in major need of being replaced. We were able to raise half of the funds needed while a group from Oregon was gracious enough to match the donations to be able to see the project completed. They brought a labor group down and completed four roofs in four days!



### Pool Clean-up


The pool was completely drained and cleaned to be up and available for the kids and staff to use this summer. It was such a blessing to get that done, but not only that, the group involved trucked in multiple loads of water to fill the pool as to not deplete the water supply of the mission.



## Financial Update

We are so thankful for the groups that came down, provided materials, and donated toward getting the projects previously noted done. There was so much that didn't make it in this newsletter. Truly without the extra financial support and manpower most of these projects would not have been able to be accomplished. The needs these kids have are many but our Lord is greater and has shown us time and time again that he will move the hearts of His people to provide the support they need.

It is our wish to live in transparency with our donors and those who might want to know. We are averaging around \$8000 in recurring monthly donations. Which is just over half of our budgeted \$15,000. The leaders at The Mission have found ways to cut back on food, staff, and projects in order to sustain operations on a smaller budget. We have laid out below where we hope to be monthly to provide a quality home for the kids. We have faith we will get there as we have seen the Lord move in some amazing ways in these last few years of being an organization. 
